Aba Model Rules

The ABA Model Rules of Professional Conduct were adopted by the ABA House of Delegates in 1983. They serve as models for the ethics rules of most jurisdictions. Before the adoption of the Model Rules, the ABA model was the 1969 Model Code of Professional Responsibility. Preceding the Model Code were the 1908 Canons of Professional Ethics (last amended in 1963).

In amending former model rules 7.1-7.5 governing attorney advertising, the ABA 's central objective was to promote simplicity amid the rules themselves, and as many states routinely use the ABA rules as a guide in promulgating their own rules, the ABA

aspired to provide the states with modern rules they could adopt, thus encouraging consistency among the individual states ' advertising rules.

Competent representation requires the legal knowledge, skill, thoroughness and preparation reasonably necessary for the representation. Comment Maintaining Competence [8] To maintain the requisite knowledge and skill, a lawyer should keep abreast of changes ...

Excerpts from the ABA Model Rules of Professional Conduct (1) is subject to Rules 1.7 and 1.9(a) only if the lawyer knows that the representation of the client involves a conflict of interest; and (2) is subject to Rule 1.10 only if the lawyer knows that another lawyer associated with the lawyer in a law firm is disqualified by Rule 1.7 or 1.9(a) with respect to the matter.

The United States Supreme Court 's decision eight weeks ago in National Institute of Family and Life Advocates v.Becerra, 138 S.
