3) Why does Unferth question Beowulf's ability? Unferth is "sick with envy" (I.502) of Beowulf's reputation and courage. From a dramatic point of view, Unferth's challenge gives Beowulf a chance to demonstrate his skill at boasting. Boasting was considered a legitimate way for a warrior to enhance his reputation, and as Beowulf tells the story of his swimming race we learn that the hero is as good at boasting as he is at fighting.

In lines 1700-84, Hrothgar warns Beowulf about the dangers of kingship. On the other hand, Hrothgar goes on to suggest that death and defeat are inevitable, pride or no pride: "death will arrive, / dear warrior, to sweep you away" (II.1767-8).
