Employees will comply with Nonprofit Network policies and procedures, and all federal, state, and local labor, health and safety standards, laws and regulations. Employee behavior outside of work may affect the reputation of the Nonprofit Network and be detrimental to funding and community relations.

(See IRS Form 990, Part VI, Section B, line 11.) For smaller nonprofits that only file the Form 990-N, make sure the board knows about the annual filing requirement. Disclose to the public the nonprofit's three most recently filed annual returns with the IRS, as well as its application for tax-exemption and related correspondence and attachments.

There are some helpful steps you can take to make the policy as helpful as possible: Discuss policy needs with your treasurer and finance committee or executive committee; Conduct an informal risk assessment; Draft the financial policy, followed by review and discussion by staff and board leadership; Present to board for adoption; Train staff on policy

Financial Policy Guidelines and Example - Propel Nonprofits

Gift acceptance policy. A gift acceptance policy establishes procedures for reviewing, accepting, and substantiating non-standard contributions. These are contributions of items that are difficult to sell and/or value—for example, vacation time-shares or stock in a privately owned company. If your nonprofit accepts such non-standard contributions, you should adopt such a policy. Chapter, branch, and affiliate policies.
