12 Strategies For Teaching Literature In The 21st-Century

Research conducted by the University of Illinois and the University of Wisconsin indicates that reading stories with children is an effective method for teaching social-emotional skills. Additional research, conducted by McCulliss and Chamberlain in 2013, suggests that using books therapeutically (bibliotherapy), in classrooms, helps foster healthy social-emotional growth in children.

6 Early literacy skills. While reading and writing aren't typically taught until after preschool, children can begin developing the skills they need to become strong readers from a very young age. Early literacy skills are actually pre-literacy skills and include wanting to look at books, following narratives, recognizing print, learning vocabulary and identifying letters and sounds.
